Definitions

CEIAG has four essential and interlinked principles these are;

- Careers Education – a planned programme in the curriculum that gives students the knowledge, skills to understand themselves, get information, and explore opportunities to manage their careers.
- Careers Information – including learning options, skills, occupations, labour market information (LMI) and progression routes.
- Careers Advice and Guidance – personalised help from specialist advisers to identify long-term goals and plan steps to attain them – Jason Davis our Careers Advisers is fully qualified - Level 6 Certificate in Career Guidance.
- Work-related learning – experiences in and outside of the curriculum which help students learn about economic well being, careers and enterprise.

Our vision is that all young people (years 7 to 13) will have access to career advise services ensuring they get the right information, advice, guidance and support they need to succeed in future education, training or employment. This requires the school, and other agencies to work together in a coherent and efficient way

We will:

- communicate development priorities to all those involved in IAG delivery
- support best practice and develop an effective shared approach to students' care, support and guidance
- identify the mechanism for recording an agreed analysis of students' need to help them achieve and progress
- set out the roles and responsibilities of key players in the delivery of Careers Education, Information, Advice and Guidance
- identify mechanisms for engaging with parents/carers and the students voice
- Deploy staff and other resources to maximum effect
- Show commitment to working in partnership to benefit students.
- Continually review our Careers Education, Information, Advice and Guidance and, through this, help drive continuous improvement
